Terms and Conditions

2. The competition is open to school children attending a Welsh school and in Year 6 or below.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

9. There will be two prizes and you can enter either one or both depending upon your geographic location.
 - a. Open to any school or group in Wales:
Build and photograph a sculpture which is made from discarded plastic picked up from a beach, river or lake. The sculpture to reflect the theme of 'Wales year of the sea'. Email, post or share your photo with RYA Cymru Wales
 - b. Open to any School or group within a 30 mile radius of Cardiff Harbour:
Submit a short paragraph (200 words) on why you think some of the crew from 'Turn the Tide on Plastic' should visit your school or group. Email to : info@all-afloat.wales
