- Cardiff schools serve pupils who live in the top 10% most deprived areas in Wales.
- Working alongside Welsh charity, All Afloat, to provide sailing experiences to local Black and Minority Ethnic community groups.
- 50 students from Mary Immaculate High School achieved their RYA Stage 1, a nationally recognised qualification.
- Back in the Classroom STEM Crew is being used to inspire more pupils about America’s Cup technology.
- Selected pupils attended Britannia’s naming ceremony as special guests of the 1851 Trust.
